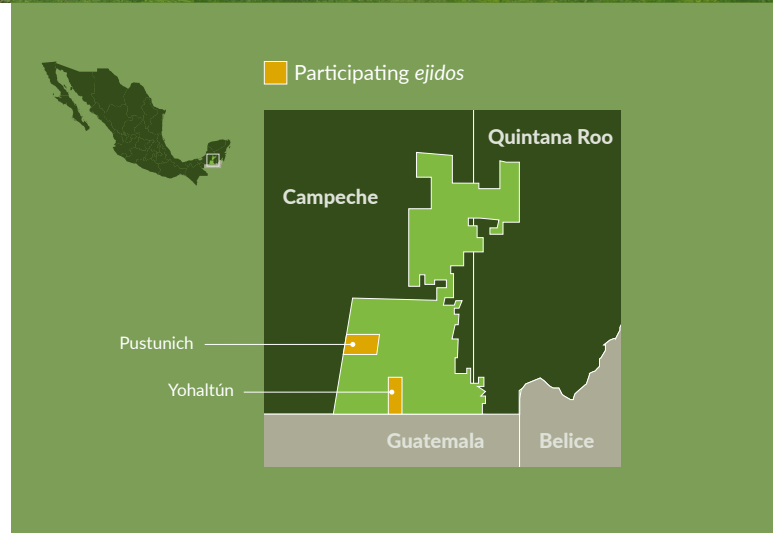

## Objective

The Calakmul Conservation Fund aims to ensure the maintenance, protection, and enrichment of biodiversity in the Calakmul Biosphere Reserve (RBC, acronym in Spanish) and its area of influence through payment for ecosystem services (PES) to two communities (*ejidos*) in the region, thus maintaining the connectivity of the jaguar habitat.



## Line of work



Support the people who own the forests that form biological corridors and that are part of the jaguars' habitat.

## Achievements

More than **680 people** benefited by PES.

**72,000 hectares** of tropical forest conserved.

Data updated at the end of 2022.
