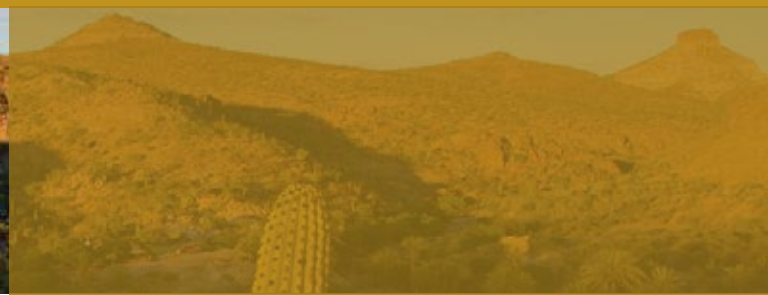

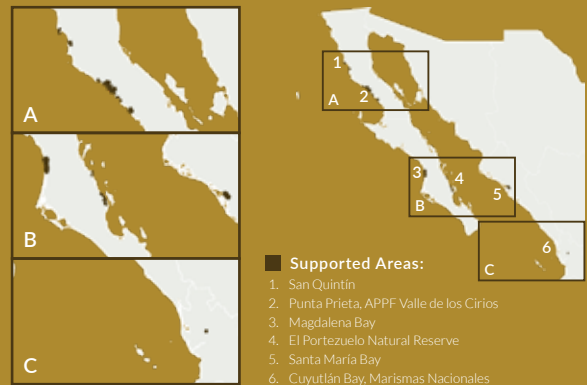

Objective

The Coastal Lands Fund aims to protect priority coastal landscapes to maintain their scenic integrity in the Northwest region of Mexico.

Currently, the fund supports the conservation and management of six private lands located in strategic sites.

Lines of work

- 1** Monitoring and management of the lands, including restoration activities, relocation expenses, and personnel costs associated.
- 2** Payment of property and other taxes, and advice on maintaining and documenting land ownership rights.
- 3** Minor infrastructure repairs and replacements, signage, and similar investments to support the management and protection of natural resources on the land.

Achievements

37,566.52 hectares under some instrument for land-use planning and territorial management.

Support for **six coastal lands** for management, monitoring and payment of property taxes.

Data updated at the end of 2024.
